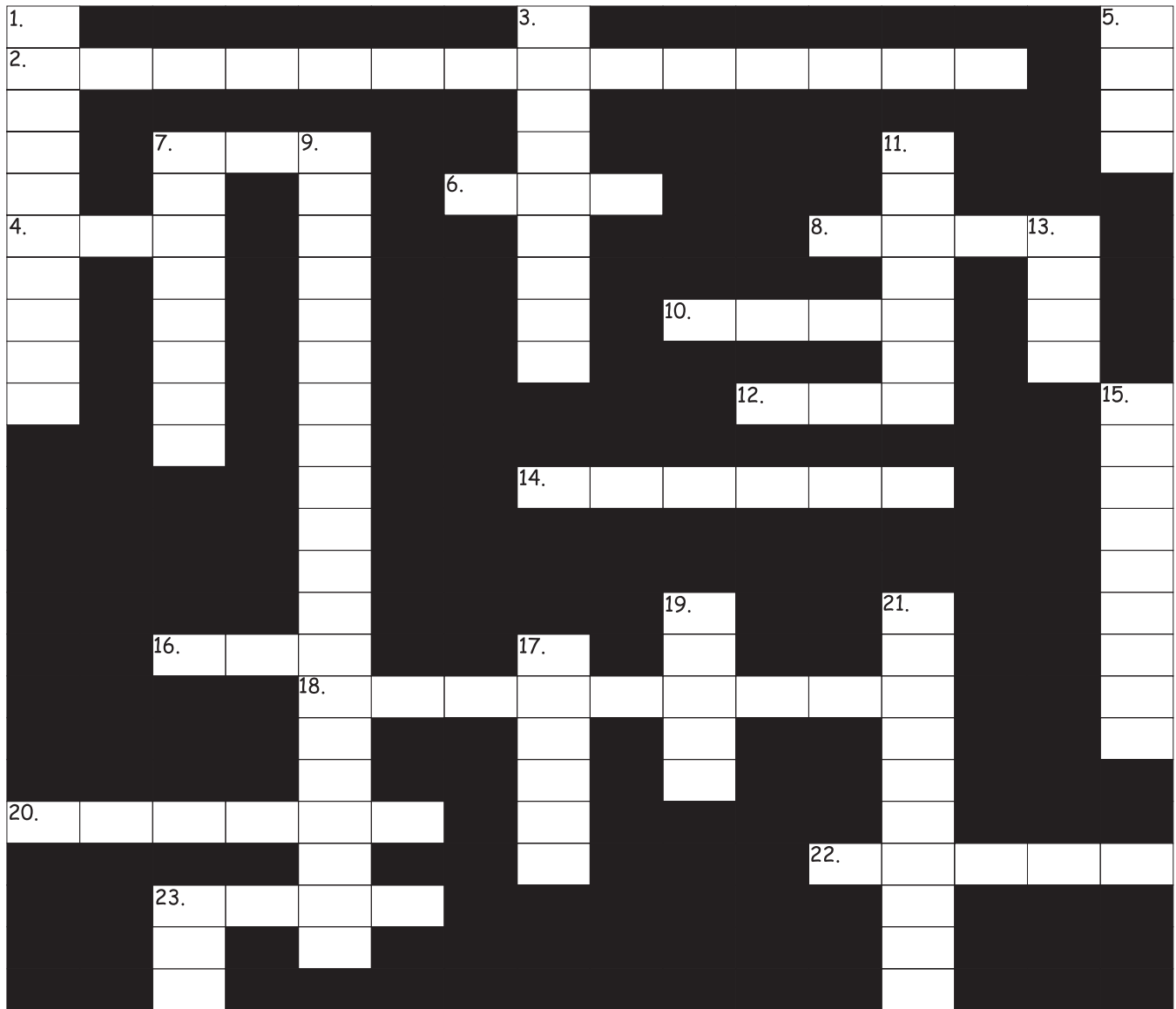


# SWAMP ANIMALS AND OCCUPATIONS CROSSWORD PUZZLE



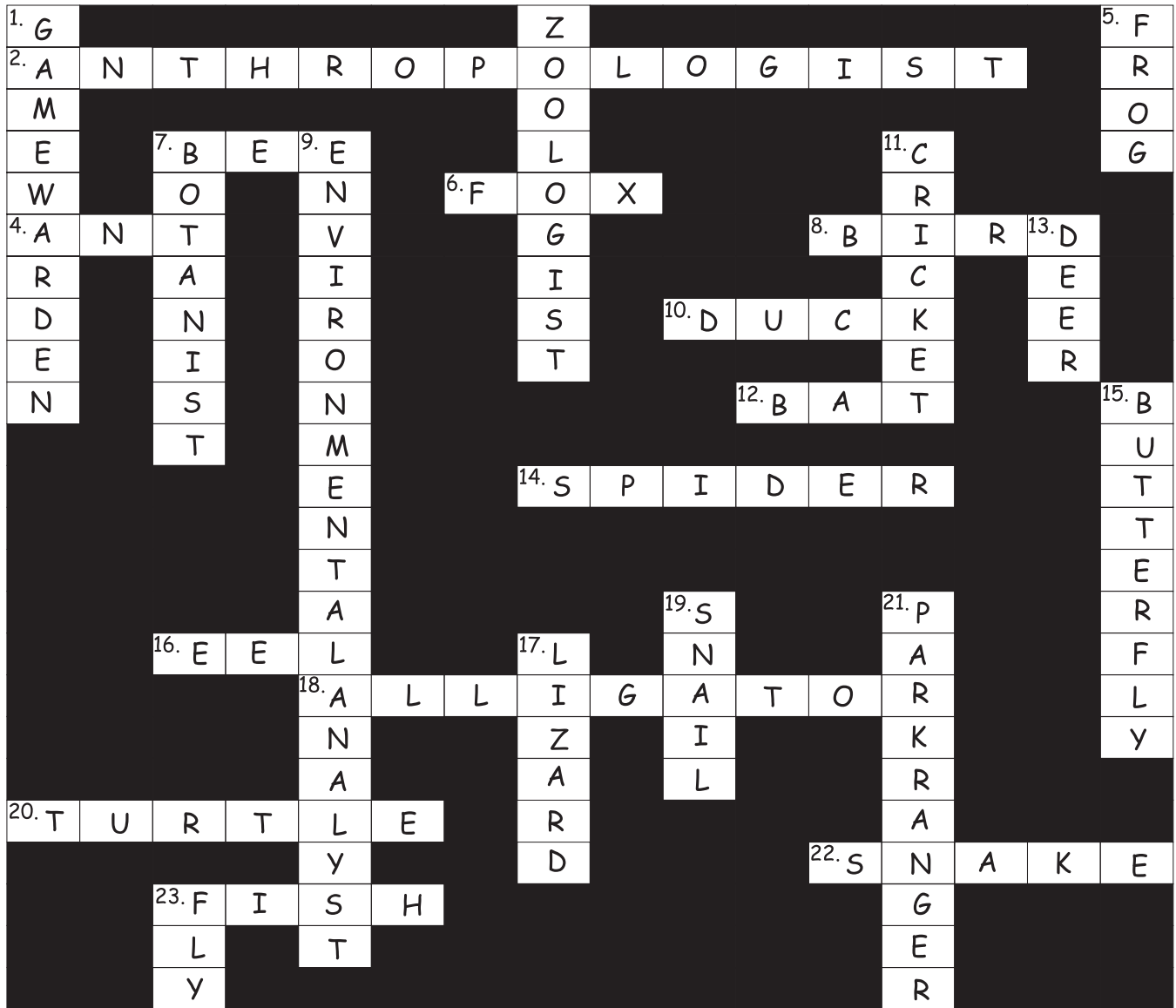
